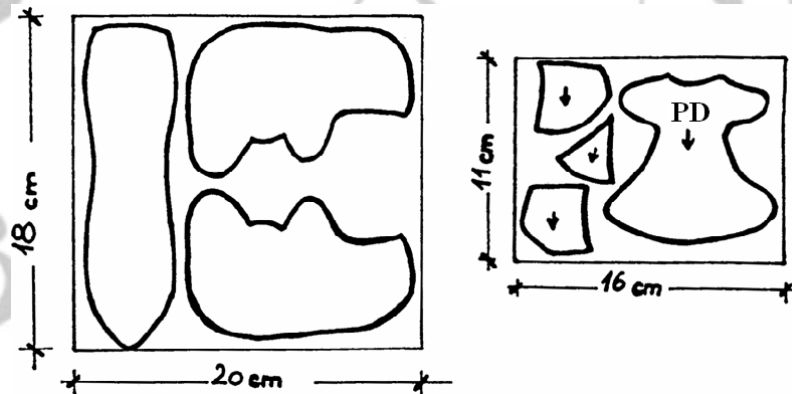


INSTRUCTION SHEET

- Please cut out the attached pattern and fix the single parts on the backside of the woven fur with pins as follows:



The pile direction (PD) must be observed while fixing the parts!

Draw the contours of the parts with a felt pen on the backside, including numbers and points (eye point). (The numbers denote the points at which the material will later be joined.)

Cut-out each part without seam allowance. To protect the long pile of the woven fur, use sharp scissors and make short cuts with the point.

- All woven fur parts will be sewed by hand using an oversowing stitch (shown in the right sketch), or by sewing-machine (suggestion: only for advanced sewer).



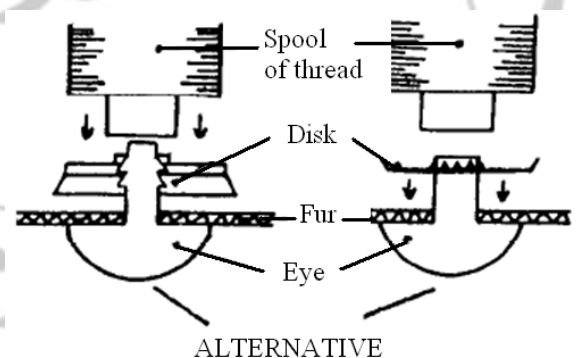
It is useful to fix the parts together with pins before you sew it, at this juncture front on front. When you pin the woven fur together, push the pile to the inside, as this keeps the pile out of the seam.

- Head

Sew both head side parts on the head middle part from point 3 to point 4. Close the seam from point 4 to point 5.

- Eyes

Please cut a cross with the scissors on the marked eye point, so that the shaft of the eye can be pushed through the cross. The eye shaft has to be plugged from the front and will be fixed with the disk on the back. Place the disk on the reverse of the material and push it down firmly using a spool of thread, as shown on the sketch to the right.



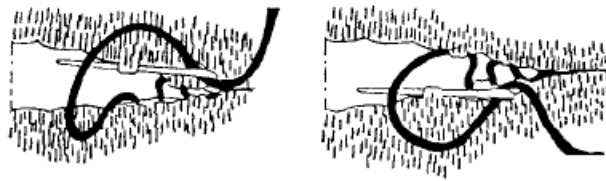
- c.) Belly
Sew the head on the belly from point 5 to point 6.
- d.) Back/Sides
Sew the body side parts on the back part from point 1 to point 2.
- e.) Connect the head/front part with the back between the points 3 and point 1. Sew the side parts on the belly between the point 6, point 7, point 8 and point 9 together.

Close the seam between point 9 and point 2 on one side, the other side will be the turning and filling opening.

Turn the ready sewn animal the right way out and fill the paws and head with the attached stuffing. The plastic granulate will be filled in the body. Now, close the turning opening between point 9 and point 2.

- 3. The turning and filling opening is sewn up using mattress stitch.

Mattress stitch: Both pieces of material are laid next to each other. You enter the needle parallel to the opening of the fur and pull the material together.



- 4. At the end, sew the Pompon with 4-5 stitches on the nose point, point 4.

Hedgehog "Robert" is finished!
